



## Top SA Cabs

The second annual **CHRISTIAN EEDES CABERNET SAUVIGNON REPORT** has found local Cabs that are, on the whole, very impressive in quality with “the thin and weedy wines of yesteryear” being replaced with premium Cabernet “characterised by richness and weight”. A total of 60 wines were tasted and Christian compiled the report in collaboration with Sanlam Private Investments. He aims



to establish a recognised benchmark for the second most planted varietal in SA.

**Five star winners are:** La Bri 2009 & Le Riche Reserve 2010. **Four-and-a-half star winners are:** Graham Beck The Coffeestone Cabernet 2011, Guardian Peak Lapa 2010, Rickety Bridge Paulina's Reserve 2010, Rudera 2011, Springfield Méthode Ancienne 2006, Thelema 2009, Waterford 2009. **The four star winner is:** Rust en Vrede 2010.
