

## Syrah 2017



### WINEMAKERS NOTES

With a deep purple ink colour, this voluptuous wine entices with subtle violet tones in dark chocolate richness. The entry is soft with well-integrated tannins leading to a velvet palate brightened with hints of pepper and cloves

### THE HARVEST

The Shiraz and Viognier grapes were picked together in the last week of February.

### IN THE CELLAR

The Shiraz and Viognier grapes were crushed and co-fermented. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel. The wine was matured for 24 months in 43% new 225L barrels

### CULTIVAR COMPOSITION

98% Shiraz, 2% Viognier

### BOTANICAL SKETCH

Each of our wines is linked to a specific flower – the characteristics of the wine are symbolized by that particular flower on the label.

### *Herbae* (Herbs)

Our **Syrah** has powerful perfumed aromas of fennel, thyme, rosemary, violet and oregano, much like one would experience whilst strolling through a herb garden.
